

Flickerball Study Guide

Object of the the Game

To pass the “football” to as many team members as possible in an attempt to score in the basketball net

The Game

- Flickerball is a combination of football and basketball
- The game is played with a football
- This is a game of teamwork, running, passing, catching, shooting.
- The offense is the team that is trying to score
- The defense is the team that is trying to stop their opponent from scoring
- Every player plays offense and defense.
- The purpose is to move the ball up the court and score
- The team with the most points at the end of the game is the winner

How to Play

- Play is started with a tip off/jump ball in the center of the playing court.
- Once the ball is in play, you may pass the ball forward, backward, and/or laterally.
- When you are making a catch you are allowed momentum steps.
- If the offense passes the ball and it is dropped or incomplete pass the ball turns over to the defense
- If the offense passes the ball and it's deflected by the defense it is a “fumble” and a free ball for either team to recover
- Once the offense is past half court they are allowed to shoot the ball
- There is no defense on the defensive side of the court

Scoring

- 1 point - Ball makes contact with the backboard and then goes through the net
- 2 points - Ball makes contact with the rim and then goes through the net
- 3 points - Ball goes straight through the net
